INDESTRUCTIBLE PAINT – SHAKEN BUT NOT STIRRED!

A substantial quantity of low gloss clear yacht varnish, recently ordered by Pinewood Studios from Indestructible Paint Ltd., Birmingham, was required to cover large areas of artificial marble.

Made from fibre-glass, the 'marble' is part of a 'palace' on the set of the latest James Bond film Casino Royale.

The surface of the fibre-glass material however, was too reflective for filming and its gloss had to be reduced to make it appear more realistic.

In addition it had to withstand immersion in water containing a number of chemicals, including chlorine, for up to a week. A variety of previously tried coatings, from a number of sources, had yellowed and/or peeled off in these conditions.

A specially produced semi-gloss version of a normally very shiny clear yacht varnish from the company's Rylard leisure marine range successfully met all of Pinewood's requirements.

As a result, Indestructible received two more orders for the same material.
